Gloria Ferrer Brut NV, Sonoma California \$36

What the critics thought: Wine Spectator 90 points—California's best value in a sparkler. Bright and complex with plenty of character.

Mumm Napa Brut Prestige NV, Napa California (split) \$10

What the critics thought: Wine Spectator 88 points—Bright and tangy with a core of toasty lime and lemon flavors.

Mumm Napa Cuvée M NV, Napa California (split) \$10

What the critics thought: Wine Enthusiast 86 points—This Extra Dry sparkler is luscious and slightly sweet, with fresh fruit and decadent flavors.

Sauvignon Blanc/Fume Blanc

Bin 115 Ferrari-Carano Fume Blanc 2008, Sonoma California \$23 Glass \$7.25

What the critics thought: Wine Spectator 87 points —Refreshingly crisp, with lemon-lime, ripe peach, green apple and subtle herb notes. There's good intensity and focus, with terrific acidity.

Bin 107 Brancott Sauvignon Blanc 2009, New Zealand \$21 Glass \$6.75

What the critics thought: Wine Spectator 89 points—Sharply focused grapefruit, lime and peach aromas and flavors competing for attention as the finish races along, persisting impressively.

Bin 135 Foris Fly Over White Pinot Blanc/Pinot Gris/Chard 2007, Rogue Oregon \$23 Glass \$7.25

What the critics thought: A Cobblestone Selection—Medium bodied, aromatic notes of green apple, melon and fig mingle with delicate Asian spices of cardamom and ginger, and a crisp finish

Bin 105 Mezzacorona Moscato 2008, Trentino Italy \$20 Glass \$6.25

What the critics thought: Wine Enthusiast 85 points—Intense nose of tropical fruit with notes of nutmeg and cinnamon, and a pleasing balance of subtle sweetness and acidity.

What the critics thought: A Cobblestone Selection—Lively notes of citrus and peach fruit interwoven with delicate layers of jasmine blossom and fresh herbs.
- Bin 111** Pine Ridge Chenin Blanc-Viognier 2008, Clarksburg CA \$26 Glass \$8.25
What the critics thought: A Cobblestone Selection—Floral and sweet with aromas of pear, melon, and a touch of pink grapefruit. The slightly off-dry finish is clean and crisp.
- Bin 103** Banfi Centine Sauvignon Blanc, Chard and Pinot Grigio 2008, Italy \$21 Glass \$6.75
What the critics thought: Wine Enthusiast 88 points—A beautiful white, with lemon, green apple and pear aromas and flavors. Medium- to full-bodied, with fresh acidity and a clean, fruity finish.
- Bin 101** pro-mis-Q-ous White Chard/Chenin Blanc/ Gewurztraminer 2009, California \$21 Glass \$6.75
What the critics thought: A Cobblestone Selection—Melon. Pear, Tangerine, Rose Petal, Lychee, Lemon Rind. Yummy.
- Bin 116** Dr. L Riesling 2008, Mosel-Saar-Ruwer Germany \$21 Glass \$6.75 **Wine Spectator Top 100**
What the critics thought: Wine Spectator 90 points—Sleek and tangy, with apricot, lime and mango flavors matched to a lively structure. There's good harmony and persistence through the finish.
- Bin 124** Mezzacorona Pinot Grigio 2009, Italy \$20 Glass \$6.25
What the critics thought: A Cobblestone Selection—The aromas embrace floral and fruity notes of citrus, peach and green melon.
- Bin 108** Ken Forrester Petit Chenin Blanc 2008, Stellenbosch South Africa \$20 Glass \$6.25
What the critics thought: Stephen Tanzer 87 points—Aromas of mint and lime, with hints of honey and resin. Supple and bright, with attractive citrus fruit flavor complicated by a note of nutmeg.

What the critics thought: Wine Spectator 90 points—Fresh, intense and vibrant, with a rich, layered mix of green apple, baked apple, pear and spice.
- Bin 129** J Lohr Chardonnay 2008 Arroyo Seco California \$21 Glass \$6.75
What the critics thought: A Cobblestone Selection—Clean with nectarine, citrus, subtle floral notes and vanilla toastiness, producing layers of complexity.

What the critics thought: Wine Spectator 90 points—Fresh, soft style of Chardonnay with bright sweet citrus fruit character and subtle spice and oak nuances.

What the critics thought: Wine Enthusiast 90 points— Powerful and intense, with jammy blackberry fruit framed by lashings of vanilla with layers of cola, coffee and chocolate.

What the critics thought: A Cobblestone Selection—The Sangiovese is all silky mouthfeel, red cherries and spices, while the Malbec brings color, body and tannins. A lovely, dry and unique wine
- Bin 132** Woop Woop Shiraz 2008, South Australia \$23 Glass \$7.25
What the critics thought: Wine Spectator 87 points — This is polished, with a cola edge to the berry flavors, finishing with some density.

What the critics thought: A Cobblestone Selection— Raspberry and cassis with baking spice and cracked pepper notes adding liveliness.
